COLLABORATIVE AGREEMENT

INTRODUCTION

This Collaborative Agreement is established to foster collaboration and enhance services between the Bayamón- Comercio Local Workforce Development Board (LWDB) and Endeavors, both dedicated to serving vulnerable communities and citizens in need. At Endeavors, we recognize that partnerships with organizations enable us to deliver broader and more effective services.

ORGANIZATION

First Party: Eliud M. Díaz González, of legal age, single, Executive of Comercio, Puerto Rico, as President of the Bayamón – Comercio Local Workforce Development Board (LWDB) hereinafter referred to as the First Party.

Second Party: *Family Endeavors* dba *Endeavors*, hereinafter referred to as “the Second Party,” is a private, non-profit organization established under the laws of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico. Its Employer Identification Number is 23-7223078. The organization’s headquarters are in San Antonio, Texas, with a satellite office at Akyna Pro Building, 3100 Carretera 199, Suite #204, San Juan, Puerto Rico, 00926. The contact telephone number is 787-520-5185. The organization is represented in Puerto Rico by **Mr. Carlos Cubero**, Director of Operations for Puerto Rico, of legal age, single, and a resident of Bayamón, Puerto Rico.

PURPOSE

The primary purpose of this agreement is to collaborate on the implementation of the following programs:

1. *Homeless Veterans’ Reintegration Program (HVRP)*
2. *Incarcerated Veterans’ Transition Program (IVTP)*
3. *Homeless Women Veterans’ and Homeless Veterans with Children Reintegration Grant Program (HWVHWC)*

These programs will hereinafter be collectively referred to as *HVRP*.

DURATION

This agreement shall take effect upon signature by both parties and will remain in force for the duration of Endeavors’ programs in Puerto Rico, as mutually agreed.

COLLABORATION

Both parties voluntarily commit to the following:

1. The First Party will refer cases to the Second Party for service under Endeavors' programs. Referrals can be made by calling 787-520-5185 or emailing prhelp@endeavors.org.
2. The Second Party will refer participants to the First Party for services offered by the First Party, benefiting the participants referred by the Second Party.
3. Both parties will collaborate on community-related activities as needed.
4. Authorized representatives of both entities will serve as primary contacts. **[Authorized Representative Name]** is designated as the contact for the First Party, and **Carlos Cubero** will represent the Second Party. Any referrals or administrative matters will be coordinated through these designated individuals.

DATA PROTECTION

Both parties agree to comply with applicable data protection laws and regulations, including the *Privacy Act of 1974 (5 U.S.C. § 552a)* and *Federal Disaster Assistance Regulations (44 C.F.R. pt. 206.110(j), 2012)*. Any personal data shared between parties will remain confidential and used solely for purposes outlined in this agreement. Security measures to safeguard personal data will be implemented and communicated between both parties.

COMMITMENT NOT TO DISCRIMINATE

Neither party shall discriminate in providing services under this agreement based on age, race, color, sex, national origin, social status, sexual orientation, gender identity, disability, political or religious beliefs, veteran status, or any other protected status.

CONSIDERATION

This agreement does not involve any monetary exchange.

SEPARABILITY AND VALIDATION

Each clause of this agreement is independent. If any clause is deemed invalid, it will not affect the validity of the remaining provisions. Any modifications to this agreement must be made in writing and signed by both parties.

RESPONSIBILITIES

This agreement does not impose financial obligations or specific responsibilities beyond the commitment to collaborate. Neither party may represent, audit, or interfere in matters outside the scope of this agreement.


CONFIDENTIALITY

Both parties are responsible for safeguarding participant information and complying with all applicable privacy laws. This agreement does not infringe upon the rights of participants.

TERM OF AGREEMENT

This agreement is valid for three (3) years and may be terminated by either party at any time through written notice addressed to the authorized representative listed in this document.
